PRESENTATION

IEP-UCP: A project for the future which is rooted in the past



he spirit of the famous 15th century Portuguese Sagres School, headed by Prince Henry the Navigator, – where international scholars, explorers and navigators gathered together to push human knowledge forward and explore the open seas of liberty – is the main inspiration of the Instituto de Estudos Políticos da Universidade Católica Portuguesa, IEP-UCP (Institute for Political Studies of the Catholic University of Portugal), which was the result of Professor Mário Pinto's initiative..

Since its foundation in **1996-97**, the Institute has gathered together most of the **best Portuguese senior scholars and professionals** in Political Science and International Relations, Security and Defence. Its **BA, MA**

and PhD Programmes have aimed at fostering an international atmosphere where longing for know-ledge and the excitement of ideas are open to all – provided one is prepared to work hard and engage in the critical examination of different lines of argument, tested by experience.

AN INTERNATIONAL NETWORK

This international atmosphere has **grown** gradually, out of **free interaction and trust**. For this reason, we believe it is stronger and it has much more potential then it would, had it been designed only by central or administrative will. It now has several dimensions:

- > An International Meeting in Political Studies which is convened by an international committee of senior scholars and takes place annually in Estoril, near Lisbon the Estoril Political Forum, which marks its 25th anniversary in 2017. These meetings have had the association of Harvard University and Boston College Summer Programs, among many other university institutions.
- > A MA programme, fully taught in English,
- MA in Governance, Leadership and Democracy Studies which is associated through a "Double Degree" protocol with the the Jagiellonian University, Krakow (founded in 1364), and with Pazmany Peter Catholic University, Budapest (founded in 1635). > A Centre for European Studies, headed by the former President of the European Commission, José Manuel Durão Barroso, which is developing and expanding the seminal work on European studies first launched in Portugal by the late Ernâni Lopes, in the 1980s.
- > An ongoing programme of **seminars and lectures** given by some of the best scholars in Political Science and International Relations coming from overseas.

- > A semester-abroad programme which allows the best IEP students to complete part of their studies at prestigious overseas Universities such as **St. Antony's** and **Lincoln Colleges** at the **University of Oxford, King's College**, London, **Georgetown University** and **Boston College**, among others. Students of these Universities are also welcome at IEP-UCP.
- > An association with other prestigious MA or PhD courses as a first step to reach joint-degree diplomas. This association now includes (1) the EUROPAEUM MA Programme in European History and Civilization, a three quarter course based in Leiden, Sorbonne-Pantheon (Paris) and

Oxford; and (2) the two-year **MA in Democracy Studies at Georgetown University**. A cooperation with the MA and PhD programmes in Political Science and International Relations offered by the **Catholic University of Mozambique**.

WESTERN TRADITION OF LIBERTY UNDER LAW

Teaching and research at IEP-UCP is based on the most demanding standards of scholarship. Our programmes cover all the standard branches of political studies and international affairs. Furthermore, we are proud of our strong emphasis on the study of the **Western Tradition of Liberty under Law** – a tradition which we perceive as a living conversation between **generations** and a living dialogue between **faith and reason** which goes back to **Athens, Rome** and **Jerusalem**.

In **Winston S. Churchil**l, we honour one of the greatest representatives of this tradition in the 20th century. We believe that the bulwark of this tradition lies on the **transatlantic relationship** between the nations of Europe and of the European Union and America. And we hold that the **Portuguese-speaking peoples** are part and want to be part of this tradition.

LIBERTY AND DUTY: EDUCATION FOR GENTLEMANSHIP

IEP-UCP is proud of being inspired by the **gentlemanly** tradition of **Oxbridge** and **Ivy League** universities. By this we mean a gentle and evolving combination of **aristocratic**, **bourgeois** and **popular** ingredients. This, we believe, is the original idea of a University: open to the best talents, regardless of their social origins. Once one is admitted on the basis of merit, one will be educated in an understanding that the **privilege of education** generates a **demanding sense of duty to the public**, rather than a self-indulgent arrogance over the public.

We **enjoy** calling this an education of **free and responsible citizens** — **gentlemen**, in the fortunate English expression. As **democracy cannot exist without democrats**, we believe that **liberty cannot survive without gentlemen**. As Sir Karl Popper used to say, *gentlemen do not take themselves too seriously, but are prepared to take their duties very seriously — especially when others talk only about their rights.*


AN EXPERIENCE TO RECALL



Double Degrees

The Institute for Political Studies of the Universidade Católica Portuguesa and the Pázmány Péter Catholic University in Budapest signed in 2014 a protocol where both institutions agreed on the establishment of a Double Degree win which students will attend one year at the Institute for Political Studies - Universidade Católica Portuguesa in Lisbon - following the programme of the MA in Governance, Leadership and Democracy Studies, and one year at the Pázmány Péter University in Budapest - Hungary - following the MA in International Studies. According to the official international ranking based on international tourists' votes, Budapest was considered the second best European city. The Institute for Political Studies of the Catholic University of Portugal and the Jagiellonian University in Krakow signed on February 20, 2014, a protocol where both institutions agreed on the establishment of a Double Degree in which students will attend one year at the Institute for Political Studies - Catholic University of Portugal, following the programme of the MA in Governance, Leadership and Democracy Studies and one year at the Jagiellonian University in Krakow - Poland, following the MA in European Studies.





EUROPAEUM: M.A. in European History & Civilisation

Leiden, Paris I (Panthéon-Sorbonne) / IEP-UCP (Lisbon), Oxford



> Leiden: near the University

Since 2006, the Institute is associated with the Europaeum Masters in European History and Civilisation. After having completed two semesters at IEP-UCP, our students may apply to this one-year programme divided into quarters, with the first quarter of teaching at Leiden, the second at Paris I and the third at Oxford, including four weeks of tutorial guidance in the preparation of a dissertation.

"Raymond Aron used to write that men make history without knowing it. Since I came in to the IEP I quickly became aware that I was inside an unparalleled academic environment in Portugal. There were three reasons that lead me to this perception: I) the academic quality of the faculty and staff; II) the innovation of curricular subjects; III) the opportunity given to each student to be able to complete his degrees in foreign academic environments of higher quality.

When I applied to the Europaeum Masters I was aware that it was, simultaneously, an opportunity and a responsibility. The opportunity to study in three of the best European academic environments – Leiden, Sorbonne and Oxford – and the responsibility of representing IEP in these institutions. 
IEP is also a member of the IMPACT (International Mobility Program on Atlantic Citizenship Trends) project, a consortium made up of four universities - UCP, University of Trier, University of Colorado in Boulder and the University of Massachusetts in Dartmouth – and recently awarded the "ATLANTIS Excellence-in-Mobility 2010-2014" grant by the European Commission and the U.S. Department of Education.

IMPACT is exclusively dedicated to the study, research and teaching of themes related to citizenship and integrating interlinked issues such as immigration, naturalization, democracy, civil society and human rights, for example.

The IMPACT program consists of a transatlantic exchange of students and professors between two European and two American universities. The UCP students selected to participate in this program are awarded study grants for one academic term (around four months). Professors accepted onto the exchange program, in turn, receive study grants of two to four weeks in duration.

EP-UCP's Career Day is an annual event that aims to introduce our students (from the 3 cycles) to different career perspectives, as well as a privileged contact with renowned professionals. The programme, which usually runs for half a day, counts with the participation of guests with a relevant professional path, who are also Alumni IEP-UCP.

It is also our aim to stimulate students to broaden their horizons by bringing them closer to national and international institutions and companies, as well as enhancing their Curriculum Vitae

Considering that the connection to the professional world is a fundamental element of academic and human training, IEP-UCP gives students (at the BA and MA levels) the possibility to carry out an internship that allows direct and practical contact with the challenges of working life.

In addition to the opportunity of a first work experience, students will be encouraged to broaden their horizons by approaching national and international institutions and companies, as well as enhancing their Curriculum Vitae.

This contact with institutions or organizations is a priority for the Institute and there are several modalities of optional internships with extra-curricular accreditation. These are unpaid internships lasting between three and six months, depending on the positive assessment given by the host institution and a student's final report.


